One small step for your kids...one giant leap for God's Kingdom!

The Lutheran Church of the Holy Spirit invites all children to blast off with Vacation Bible School! **VBS: To Mars and Beyond** will help kids discover the wonders of God's universe. They'll become Voyagers on a journey through space, exploring where God's power can take them. They'll lift off to distant planets on special missions to collect power sources. This out-of-this-world adventure will begin on June 24 and ends June 28. VBS is held from 9:15 am – 12:00 pm.

Along the way, they'll learn how God walked with heroes of the Bible, and that God is always with them, too. Add to the adventure with out-of-this-world fun, learning, and timeless Bible stories that inspire kids to give glory to God, who is able to do far beyond all that we could ask or imagine!

The overall theme verse is from Ephesians 3:20- "God is able to do much more than we ask or think through God's power working in us." Each day the students hear a daily theme that connects to the Bible story of the day. The phrase helps to make the key teaching of the day easier to remember. In order to add to the excitement and build community at VBS, we ask our participants to wear a special color each day.

Monday (GREEN) Go Beyond with Faith!
Tuesday (YELLOW OR PURPLE) Go Beyond with Boldness!
Wednesday (BLUE) Go Beyond with Kindness!
Thursday (RED) Go Beyond with Thankfulness!
Friday (ORANGE OR WHITE) Go Beyond with Hope!



April 2019 Financial Results and Discussion

Operating Performance: April net income turned out to be less than what we expected. Income was \$76,230 and expenses were \$76,814 which gave us a deficit of \$584. We had budgeted a surplus of \$3,658.

S BUDGET NEWS

Thrivent totals were \$2,591 while we had budgeted \$1,895.

Total expenses were very close to budget, only over budget by \$914. They totaled \$76,814 while we had anticipated expenses to be \$75,900. Most mission areas were close or under budget.

Pledged revenue was \$7,219 less than plan and unpledged revenue was \$1,908 less than plan. Overall our income was \$76,230 while we had budgeted \$79,558, a \$3,328 difference.

Projected vs. budgeted cash balance: At this point it looks like we will end the year with a cash balance of \$82,221 but we thought we'd have \$95,754. Just a friendly reminder to please stay current on your pleages so we can make up this difference!

Capital Campaign Cash: Our capital campaign balance decreased during April to \$25,218 due to two expenses totaling \$2,741. These include interest on our Mission Investment Fund loan and the second invoice for our Capital Campaign fee from Kirby-Smith Associates. Donations totaled \$155.

HVAC System: The balance on our Mission Investment Fund for the HVAC system is \$124,030.

Building Fund: Our building fund decreased to \$3,526 due to a \$1,660 expense for a PTAC replacement. Donations totaled \$1,299 for the month of April.


Project HELP 2019




