

MINUTES FOR LCHS COUNCIL ELECTRONIC VOTE OF AUGUST 1-5, 2020

By electronic mail on August 1, 2020, Robert Stevens, on behalf of the Re-opening Task Force, requested that Council members vote on the motion (below).

Motion: It is moved that starting September 13, 2020, the Family Service will move to 9:00 AM, the Spirit Alive Service will move to 10:00 AM, and the Center for Faith and Life (CFL) will be held at 11:00 AM. This schedule would apply through Sunday, October 25, 2020.

The following were noted during the initial presentation of the motion: (1) both of the Sunday services and CFL will be virtual; (2) there will be no Sunday School, but some Christian education will be included in the Family Service; and (3) schedules will be reassessed in October to determine the schedule for the remainder of the calendar year. Adoption of a schedule allows staff and the CFL Board to complete planning for the fall. Communication of the adopted schedule would be announced on Sunday, August 9.

As the first person responding electronically to the motion, the motion was seconded by Sue Mathieu. Affirmative responses were electronically received from the following by August 5, 2020: M. There were no responses indicating an objection to the motion. (No responses were received by August 5 from K. McNally or Pr. S. Steele.)

The motion was approved by a vote of 14 to 0 (zero).
