

MINUTES FOR LCHS COUNCIL ELECTRONIC VOTE OF JUNE 28-30, 2020

By electronic mail on June 28, 2020, Nina McNally, on behalf of the Outreach Mission Team, requested that Council members vote on Outreach's motion (below).

Motion: The Outreach Mission Team would like to establish a small produce garden (two 6x4 foot aluminum, raised beds) adjacent to the parking lot near the office with the harvested produce being donated to the local food bank.

The following were noted during the initial presentation of the motion: (1) preparation and planting would begin shortly after July 6, to allow for completion of tree work scheduled in that area; (2) the beds are available from local Rotary Clubs; (3) Marilyn Egner, with John Mosovsky and others, would lead the effort for this growing season; and (4) the church would provide access to water and information regarding optimum placement of the beds, to allow for lawn mowing.

The motion was seconded by Rick Doty. Affirmative responses were electronically received from the following on June 28, 2020: M. Binkley, M. Blower, F. Casciano, R. Doty, Pr. R. Elliott, K. Ervin, S. Mathieu*, C. McGrath, K. McNally, N. McNally, C. Pirrotta, Pr. T. Reichley, D. Rohrbach, M. Stanziola, and Pr. S. Steele. R. Stevens stated his approval on June 30, with the condition that the area outside room 117/119 be used rather than an area adjacent to the staff parking lot.

*S. Mathieu initially conditioned her approval on development of a long term plan for the project. N. McNally responded to that concern via e-mail on June 28, indicating that Outreach would be looking at the future plan for the project and communicating that plan to Council. Based on that response, S. Mathieu on June 30th removed the condition on her approval of the motion.

The motion was approved by a vote of 15 to 0 (zero), with an additional approval based on reconsideration of the planting area to be used.
