## Financial Results and Discussion – November 2020

**Operating Performance:** November operating income of \$58,937 was \$1,370 higher than expected. November operating expenses of \$84,182 were \$14,250 higher than expected. In our continued focus on outreach, Council authorized paying the remainder of 2020 budgeted benevolence in November rather than December which added \$16,000 to November expenses. As a result, our net income for November was below projections by \$12,880 (-\$25,245 actual rather than the expected -\$12,365). With the November operating results our operating cash reserve is \$98,924.

We received some fantastic news this month! Our PPP loan of \$136,474 was fully converted to a grant. We used \$9,962 to pay salaries for the Nursery School last Spring, and the remainder to pay staff salaries and utilities in May-July. Since the funds were a loan until this month, they were not reflected in our operating results. With the conversion to a grant, \$126,511 was now income. Council authorized spending \$17,961 to pay back a loan to our Endowment Fund to help repair the roof in 2015. Council reserved \$20,000 to help cover potential losses for the Nursery School in the 2020-2021 academic year due to reduced enrollment from COVID protocols. Finally, Council authorized \$36,175 for the down payment on the new organ. Those funds will be reflected as income in 2021 when we receive the donations designated for the organ. The final \$52,376 was added to cash reserves raising our current balance to \$151,300.

**Spirit Led, Spirit Alive Capital Campaign Cash:** The current total in our Spirit Led, Spirit Alive account is \$465,605. Total donations for the month of November were \$44,370. The two expenses for the month were for interest on our Mission Investment Fund loan for the HVAC (\$223) and paying down that same loan by \$10,000.

**HVAC System:** The balance on our Mission Investment Fund loan for the HVAC system is \$50,000.

**Building Fund:** Our building fund decreased to \$16,013 during the month of November. Donations totaled \$1,533. There was an expense for two dehumidifiers (\$3,100). Thank you for your continued support of our Building Fund!

### **OUTREACH CAUSE OF THE MONTH - *In-Reach is Outreach Too!***

We often think of Outreach as helping people in need – often focusing on those ‘outside our church walls’. The Outreach Mission Team would like to encourage you to reach *within* our communities this month and be intentional about connecting with one another. During this time of social isolation, the Advent/Christmas season may be difficult. There are many among us – in our Holy Spirit family, our individual families, even our next-door neighbor...who may be experiencing emotional, mental or spiritual struggles.

Let us reach out! Send a card. Take a random page from the church directory and make some calls. Share your story or a scripture verse. Check-in with a distant friend or family member. Intentionally pray for one another. *You are not alone. We are in this together – with God!*

Plaster House is a home where Tanzanian children with treatable disabilities such as burns from home cooking fires, club foot, cleft palate, and bent legs caused from skeletal fluorosis, can prepare for and recover from corrective surgery. It is one of many ministries envisioned and developed by ELCA missionaries Dr. Mark and Linda Jacobson and many partners. Newly constructed housing now serves 160 children. At the moment,

\$4 supports one child for one day at The Plaster House

\$10 provides one special feeding bottle for therapeutic feeding program

\$20 provides shoes/foot abduction brace for one child following clubfoot treatment

\$50 provides 10 locally made reusable diapers

\$100 provides one month of rehab and residential stay for one child

\$200 provides feeding program formula for one child for one month

\$500 provides monthly salary for one therapy staffer
