The following areas of opportunities for ministry are available at Holy Spirit. The descriptive paragraphs for each category include examples of the activities but is not a full list. Administration

Administration involves such issues as attendance recording, data entry, mailings, proofreading and acting as a substitute receptionist.

Adult Faith Formation and Interest Groups

The area of Adult Faith Formation involves Bible studies, book groups, Prime Timers Senior Group, M&Ms, Too women's group, The Center for Faith and Life Adult Education, and participatory ministries such as Stitch 'n Chat quilters, prayer chain, and Circle of Friends.

Children Faith Formation (birth thru 5th grade)

Among the ways for involvement in the Children Faith Formation ministry are: Sunday School teacher, teacher substitute and helper; knitter/crocheter, Vacation Bible School leaders and assistants, CAT Club, and Growing in Faith Together events.

Hospitality and Fellowship

Those who serve as members of Hospitality and Fellowship may be involved in activities such as Sunday Morning Coffee, special events, summer breakfasts, baking and kitchen helpers.

Member Care

Those involved with Member Care may coordinate meal preparation for members in need, participate in the prayer chain, Health Ministry, Eucharistic Ministry, Prayer Shawl Ministry, visit or write to shut-ins, flower delivery, Bloomin' Faith floral distribution, and Stephen Ministry.

Music

There are multiple ways to be involved in the music ministry of the congregation. Among them are: Music Circle for preschool thru kindergarten, Children's Chimes Choir, Festival Choir, Adult Choir, Rejoicing Spirits Ringers, Praise Ensemble, instrumentalists, vocalists and drumming ensemble.

Outreach

Opportunities for participation in this area of ministry include acting as an advisor to high school and younger youth, Catechism Classes and Camp, ELCA Youth Gathering, driver for youth events, Souper Bowl of Caring, planning youth events, and chaperone for youth events.
