

### November 2023 Financial Results and Discussion

**Operating Performance:** November's income was \$54,199, 15% under budget. Operating expenses were \$55,296, 25% under budget. We finished November with a \$1,097 deficit, compared to a budgeted deficit of \$8,897.

The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirements.

- Straight Line at \$69,000: This represents our monthly cash requirement to run the church.
- Upper Line: This represents our current operating cash balance at the end of each month.



**Building Fund:** The building fund increased \$1,005 during the month to a balance of \$11,509.

**Spirit Led Spirit Alive:** This fund decreased \$1,506 during the month and has a balance of \$8,247.

Our Youth Group had a blast at our Holiday Lock In! They played a variety of games, made delicious cookies, decorated our Fellowship Center, and cleaned up for church that Sunday. Many of our youth brought their friends to share in the holiday fun. We love our youth!
