
HOLY SPIRIT CHRISTIAN NURSERY SCHOOL



Financial Results and Discussion - December 2023


Operating Performance: December's income was \$95,020, 13% over budget. Operating expenses were \$95,625, 4% under budget. We finished December with a \$605 deficit, compared to a budgeted deficit of \$15,527. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirements.


- Straight Line at \$69,000: This represents our monthly cash requirement to run the church.
- Upper Line: This represents our current operating cash balance at the end of each month.



Building Fund: The building fund increased \$1,850 during the month to a balance of \$13,359.

Spirit Led Spirit Alive: This fund increased \$11,394 during the month and has a balance of \$19,641.
