THROUGH OUR HANDS - MEDICAL SUPPLIES TO THOSE IN NEED

In May, we have the chance to send medical and related supplies to those in need around the globe. Priority needs are for the following:

- supplies for newborn through 3-month-old babies (receiving blankets, undershirt "onesies", small soaps, or shampoos)
- wound care supplies (larger bandages, sterile pads, gauze wraps), and toiletries for parents accompanying small children while in the hospital (toothpaste, toothbrushes, small soaps)

Donations will be collected in the Fellowship Center lobby through the month of May. They will be distributed primarily overseas to developing countries using the non-profit Through These Hands, based in Slatington, PA. (Larger equipment in good shape may also be donated – e.g., crutches, walkers, and wheelchairs meeting current safety standards.)




Room 113 has been transformed!

April Financial Results and Discussion

Operating Performance: April's income was \$59,361, \$16,189 or 21.43% below budget. Operating expenses were \$73,617, \$873 or 1.17% below budget. We finished April with a \$14,256 deficit, compared to a budgeted surplus of \$1,060. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirements.

- Straight Line at \$70,000: This represents our monthly cash requirement to operate the church.
- Upper Line: This represents our current operating cash balance at the end of each month.



Building Fund: The building fund decreased \$1,682 during the month and has a balance of \$28,602.

Mortgage Update: The mortgage balance as of April 30, 2024, is \$375,741.22.
