

Financial Results and Discussion - July 2024

Operating Performance: July's income was \$66,756, \$11,906 or 21.71% above budget. Operating expenses were \$67,508, \$1,263 or 1.91% above budget. We finished July with a \$752 deficit, compared to a budgeted deficit of \$11,396. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirements.

- Straight Line at \$70,000: This represents our monthly cash requirement to operate the church.
- Upper Straight Line: This represents our **current** operating cash balance at the end of each month.
- Upper Dotted Line: This represents our **projected** operating cash balance at the end of the remaining months of the year.

NOTE: While we have ended the first half of the calendar year with a strong operating fund balance (also known as operating reserve), we expect this to deteriorate in the coming months as indicated by the dashed line from August through December. Later this month we will be communicating additional details to the congregation explaining our projected revenues and expenses for the balance of 2024, as well as actions that can be taken to mitigate the projected deterioration of the operating fund balance.



Building Fund: The building fund increased \$485 during the month and has a balance of \$26,605.

Mortgage Update: The mortgage balance as of July 31, 2024, is \$372,797.68.
