I want to bring your attention to several events related to our Senior Pastor transition.

-- Sunday August 4th will be Pastor Shari Duminy's first Sunday with us as our new Senior Pastor. We will have a Welcome liturgy for Pastor Shari as part of all 3 services that day along with our typical Sunday morning summer breakfast. An installation service for Pastor Shari will be scheduled later this year based on availability of Northeast PA synod representatives and other special guests.

Also, as communicated to the congregation in June, our current agreement with our Interim Associate Pastor (Cindy Camp) was modified in April to provide for Pastor Cindy to continue serving us in her interim role for up to 3 months (October 31) following the start date of Pastor Shari (August 1). This will help us maintain our current ministries through the critical initial months of our Senior Pastor transition. During this transition period we as a congregation, working with Pastor Shari, Pastor Tami and leadership from Staff and Council, will determine the level of ordained/rostered staff that we will have for 2025 and beyond.
