ELCA World Hunger Appeal



During this Lenten Season we will be focusing on support of the ELCA World Hunger effort.

Over 821 million people in the world, 11% of the world's population, are hungry. In the United States alone over 40 million people are unsure where their next meal is coming from.

The ELCA World Hunger program is making a difference around the world. Ending hunger is about more than just providing food; it is about providing a road to long-term sustainability and change. The ELCA is actively involved in: Connecting people with the resources they need to

produce food and gain access to clean water. Provide education, health care and sources of income to bring about long-term sustainability.

In 2017, ELCA World Hunger support topped \$21.3 million in aid. The ELCA World Hunger program is active in 62 countries in the world including the United States. Projects supported by the ELCA World Hunger program include:

Establishing health clinics
Providing micro loans
Building water wells
Establishing animal husbandry programs
Providing community meals

Establishing advocacy programs to influence country and local governments

The ELCA World Hunger programs provides valuable assistance around the globe. This program depends on financial support from ELCA congregations like Holy Spirit. We can help support these efforts during this Lenten season. Matthew 25:35 states this best; "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in."

Our Lenten collection from February 11th – March 24th will be monetary donations for God's Global Barnyard, an ELCA World Hunger initiative. The program is designed to break the cycle of hunger and poverty by providing animals to families in need. The Sunday School children will receive a barn bank to fill with coins, paper money and checks. A donation of just \$10 provides for the purchase of chicks. The chicks begin to lay eggs within a few months and provide the family with protein rich meals. If an additional bank is needed, please see Karin Kahler.

During the month of February we will also collect laundry detergent for Angel Network. Donations can be either jugs of detergent or pods (preferably in bags).

OUTREACH ACTIVITIES SUMMARIES

Global Mission Fundraising (December 2023 – January 2024)

Contributions for the support of the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at the Arusha Lutheran Medical Center totaled \$3,740 as of January 23rd. With that generosity, Holy Spirit members have ensured that care is given to numerous tiny children of God struggling in their first days of life.

Holy Spirit members also contributed \$1,100 to Kafika (Plaster) House to support their care and treatment of children with correctible disabilities and \$50 to Widows Might to support craft production by widows learning to support their families after the deaths of their husbands.

A real outpouring of the Spirit from our members!
