Maria Samaritano will be speaking at Coffee, Tea & Connect on Sunday, March 9th. Come to hear more about the amazing work Maria is doing in Lehigh & Northampton Counties to help foster families as well as families at risk of losing their children to foster care. Do you know what the primary reason children end up in foster care? It's not abuse. It's poverty. Poverty creates a situation where parents cannot adequately provide necessities for their children. Maria generously gives of her time to coordinate with the county case workers and various individuals and organizations throughout the Lehigh Valley to collect items (new and gently used) to help families. She issues a detailed newsletter each week, typically on Thursdays, identifying the needs. You can sign-up to donate via a link to Signup Genius in the outreach newsletter. Maria coordinates with those donating to collect the items and deliver to the case workers.


FRAUDULENT EMAILS Just a reminder about scam emails falsely claiming to be from a pastor or other staff member from Holy Spirit. If you receive an unexpected message asking for money, gift cards, or personal information, do not respond. Instead, report it as phishing to your email provider and then delete it. Always double check the sender's email address. Official emails from Holy Spirit will come from the @holyspirit-emmaus.org domain. However, be aware that scammers can sometimes spoof legitimate addresses. If an email seems suspicious, do not click on links or download attachments. If in doubt, please contact the church office for clarification or to report any future scam attempts.

Financial Results and Discussion January 2025

Operating Performance: January's income was \$115,113, \$13,229 or 12.98% above budget. Operating expenses were \$108,110, \$3,025 or 2.72% below budget. We finished January with a \$7,003 surplus, compared to a budgeted deficit of \$9,251. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirement January - December.

Thank you to everyone that continues to share their financial gifts in support of our ministries!

- **Straight Line at \$120,000**: Represents our 6-week cash requirement to operate the church.
- **Upper Straight Line:** Represents our **current** operating cash balance at the end of each month.



Building Fund: The building fund increased \$685.00 during the month and has a balance of \$2,566.44.

Mortgage Update: The mortgage balance as of January 31, 2025, is \$365,923.75.
