Slam the Scam Day was on March 6.

Slam the Scam is an initiative by the Social Security Administration to raise awareness and give you information to recognize scams and to stop scammers from getting your money and personal information. Scammers pretend to be

from an agency or organization you know, say there is a problem or offer a prize. The pressure is put on to act now. Be aware of odd ways of paying, for example, gift cards or cryptocurrency. Scammers can be very persuasive and may use aggressive tactics to convince you that their call is legitimate. If you receive a suspicious call, remember to stay calm and HANG UP immediately. Do not engage with the caller or provide any personal information.

THRIVENT CHOICE DOLLARS

If you are a Thrivent client you may be able to direct your Thrivent Choice Dollars to the Lutheran Church of the Holy Spirit. To qualify for Thrivent Choice Dollars, you must meet one of the following qualifications:



- 1. Have \$750 or more in annual billed premiums of qualifying life or health insurance products.
- 2. Have \$20,000 or more in contract value of qualifying life insurance or annuity products.

Thrivent Choice Dollars are earned every calendar year and can be directed to the organization of your choice by March 31st of the following year. You have until March 31, 2025 to designate the direction of your 2024 Thrivent Choice Dollars. You can designate your choice of organizations on the Thrivent website. 



February 2025 - Financial Results and Discussion

Operating Performance: February's income was \$75,920, \$16,558 or 17.9% below budget. Operating expenses were \$72,930, \$8,716 or 10.67% below budget. We finished February with a \$2,990 surplus, compared to a budgeted surplus of \$10,832. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirement January - December.

Thank you to everyone that continues to share their financial gifts in support of our ministries!

- **Straight Line at \$120,000**: Represents our 6-week cash requirement to operate the church.
- **Upper Straight Line**: Represents our **current** operating cash balance at the end of each month.



Building Fund: The building fund increased \$675.00 during the month and has a balance of \$3,241.44.

Mortgage Update: A \$10,000 principal paydown of the mortgage was applied in February. The mortgage balance as of February 28, 2025, is \$354,823.39.


ELCA World Hunger Appeal
