Arrange: bouquets are created the Friday morning before delivery in the church kitchen.



Financial Results and Discussion - March 2025

Operating Performance: March income was \$119,453, \$11,383 or 10.53% above budget. Operating expenses were \$84,021, \$2,115 or 2.46% below budget. We finished March with a \$35,433 surplus, compared to a budgeted surplus of \$21,935. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirement January - December.

Thank you to everyone that continues to share their financial gifts in support of our ministries!

- **Straight Line at \$120,000**: Represents our 6-week cash requirement to operate the church.
- **Upper Straight Line**: Represents our **current** operating cash balance at the end of each month.
- **Upper Dotted Line**: Represents our **projected** operating cash balance through year end.



Building Fund: The building fund increased \$1,496.00 during the month and has a balance of \$4,737.44.

Mortgage Update: The mortgage balance as of March 31, 2025 is \$354,823.39.

<u>Income:</u> Income for the 1st quarter is about 3% above budget. We continue to have several members fulfill their annual estimate of giving at the beginning of the year, which is a great help to cash flow.

Expenses: Expenses for the 1st quarter were 5% lower than budget. People expenses were lower due to not having a full-time sexton. The Resources for Ministry expense line includes all our service contracts, building maintenance, and technology expenses. Lower expenses than projected during Q1 were driven in part by less building repairs, technology needs and the timing of some annual service contract payments being different than budgeted.

Summary

We finished the 1st quarter with a \$45,426 surplus, compared to a budgeted surplus of \$23,516. While this is positive news, we expect that our operating reserve will decrease later in the year as the impact of the fulfilled annual estimates of giving is spread over time and expenses normalize to budgeted levels.
