#### WE'RE OFF TO TANZANIA!



In May, after months of planning, travelers from Holy Spirit will make their (long) way to Tanzania to visit and learn from our siblings in Tanzania. The group will meet with representatives of 14 different organizations doing ministry in that east African country. Thanks to your generosity we will be distributing over \$30k to those organizations to help them minister to some of the world's most vulnerable people. Thanks also to the Sunday School for

collecting school supplies to take with us, and to the Youth Group for making friendship bracelets and writing letters to girls at the Lutheran secondary school.

Please remember, however, that a primary reason for the travel is that the team expects to learn from them as well, such as how to understand the people and the needs surrounding us, how to listen to God and learn His will under different circumstances, and how to appreciate what you have, even if that is not what you think you want. The group will be commissioned on May 18<sup>th</sup>. Please pray for the group, for safety and for their giving and for their learning. Please pray for yourselves as well, for helping the group take some Holy Spirit culture with them and for recognizing that lessons about God can come from every encounter, in nearby and faraway places.

#### **Sunday School Collection**

Family Worship/Sunday School collections:

On Sunday, May 4 and Sunday, May 11, we will be collecting **white socks, pens, and pencils**. The members of our congregation that are traveling to Tanzania in a few weeks will take these items along and distribute them to a variety of organizations that they will visit. The socks should be suitable for age 3 and up.

Beginning Sunday, May 18 and running through Sunday, June 8 we will be collecting items for students in East Penn School District by supporting the Emmaus Rotary Club and East Penn Food Coalition's food drive. Items needed are:

- Cans of soup (10-12 oz)
- Cans of pasta (14-16 oz)
- Cans of fruits and vegetables (14-15 oz)
- Cans of tuna fish and chicken (5 oz)
- Boxes of rice and pasta (14-16 oz)
- Boxes of cereal, non-sweetened (14-17 oz)
- Jars of peanut butter (16 oz)
- Shelf stable milk (32 oz/quart)
- Juice boxes (6-7 oz)

This year's Spring Mission Trip was a tremendous success. During our four days in York, 15 church members and friends provided home repair assistance to five families in the York area. At one home, we tore out a bathroom floor, installed subflooring and then retiled the bathroom. At another home, we removed carpeting and did major reconstruction work under the kitchen

sink area which

had suffered extensive water damage. We stained three outdoor ramps, two of which we installed last year. It was a wonderful time sharing this rewarding work with a wonderful group of individuals. On the last workday, the lady whose bathroom floor we replaced, emotionally thanked us with tears in her eyes. She told us she could never have been able to get this work done on her own. Seeing her appreciation and thankfulness made all the work during the week worthwhile.
