

Financial Results and Discussion - May 2025

Operating Performance: May income was \$89,689, \$10,245 or 12.90% above budget. Operating expenses were \$72,752, \$6,035 or 7.66% below budget. We finished May with a \$16,937 surplus,-compared to a budgeted surplus of \$656. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirement April - December.

Thank you to everyone that continues to share their financial gifts in support of our ministries!

- **Straight Line at \$120,000**: Represents our 6-week cash requirement to operate the church.
- **Upper Straight Line**: Represents our **current** operating cash balance at the end of each month.
- **Upper Dotted Line**: Represents our **projected** operating cash balance through year end.



Building Fund: The building fund increased \$1,025.00 during the month and has a balance of \$6,277.44.

Mortgage Update: The mortgage balance as of May 31, 2025, is \$352,731.22.
