

Financial Results and Discussion - July 2025

Operating Performance: July income was \$67,438, \$2,938 or 4.55% above budget. Operating expenses were \$94,802, \$7,132 or 7.00% below budget. We finished July with a \$27,364 deficit, compared to a budgeted deficit of \$37,434. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirement **April - December.**

Thank you to everyone that continues to share their financial gifts in support of our ministries!

- **Straight Line at \$120,000**: Represents our 6-week cash requirement to operate the church.
- **Upper Straight Line**: Represents our **current** operating cash balance at the end of each month.
- **Upper Dotted Line**: Represents our **projected** operating cash balance through year end.



Building Fund: The building fund increased \$465.00 during the month and has a balance of \$7,527.44.

Mortgage Update: The mortgage balance as of July 31, 2025, is \$350,636.92.
