Past Sunday School Collection

Recently our Family Worship participants collected new and gently used books for Cops-n-Kids. We exceeded our goal of 1,000 books, and 1,249 books were recently delivered to their reading room located in Bethlehem. These books will be distributed to children at their summer reading room events as well as during several back-to-school supply events that Cop-n-Kids participates in.

During the month of July, we collected diapers and wipes for foster children who are served through Lehigh County Children and Youth Services. 1,377 diapers and 4,196 wipes were collected. These items will be delivered in August to help foster families and kinship placements meet the needs of children in their care.

One kinship family who will receive a donation is a grandmother who is raising four of her grandchildren. Money is tight and she was not expecting to have the expense of raising four young children at this time in her life. Periodically she receives assistance so the children do not enter the foster care system and stay with family.
