



Financial Results and Discussion - August 2025

Operating Performance: August income was \$80,025, \$1,604 or 2.00% above budget. Operating expenses were \$70,145, \$9,410 or 11.80% below budget. We finished August with a \$9,879 surplus, compared to a budgeted deficit of \$1,135. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirement **April - December.**

Thank you to everyone that continues to share their financial gifts in support of our ministries!

- **Straight Line at \$120,000**: Represents our 6-week cash requirement to operate the church.
- **Upper Straight Line**: Represents our **current** operating cash balance at the end of each month.
- **Upper Dotted Line**: Represents our **projected** operating cash balance through year end.



Building Fund: The building fund increased \$555.00 during the month and has a balance of \$8,082.44.

Mortgage Update: The mortgage balance as of August 31, 2025, is \$349,602.90.

STITCH-N-CHAT

Stitch —n- Chat is a quilt knotting group that started in member's homes and moved to the Lutheran Church of the Holy Spirit, Emmaus, PA in 2004. Its mission is to create quilts, using donated fabrics and give

them to charitable organizations. For 20+ years, they have done just that. When donated fabrics come in, volunteers cut them into squares (11, 9, 6 or 5"). Patchwork designs are created and sewn into the tops by home sewers.

Twice a month, the tops are brought in to the church, matched with a bottom fabric, and a fiberfill bat is put between the layers. Knots are sewn to keep the layers together using a coordinating color cotton crochet thread. Once knotted, other volunteers bind the edges to finish them.

Twice a year the finished quilts are displayed in the sanctuary by laying them over the backs of the pews. It is a beautiful sight. During the service, congregants are asked to lay hands on them as a special blessing is said – blessings for the recipients and thanksgiving for the creators. The quilts are then delivered to helping agencies in the Lehigh Valley and beyond, as well as given to members who need personal support.

Over the years, more than 20 organizations have received quilts and over 20 volunteers per month spent countless hours and have created an average of 150 quilts a year.

Funds are needed to purchase the fiberfill batting. Today, Thrivent Financial for Lutherans has donated money for the batting thru a Thrivent Action grant for which we give thanks.
