This is a great opportunity to help various local community organizations working side by side with fellow Holy Spirit members. We will be putting together care bags to help those in need.

We are collecting the following for each care bag: **toothpaste**, **toothbrush**, **bar of soap**, **shampoo**, **Chapstick**, **pocket pack of tissues**, **wide tooth comb**, **and deodorant**. Local organizations receiving the bags are: Neighborhood House, Allentown Rescue Mission, Loads of Blessings (i.e. Laundry on Linden), Turning Point, Lehigh Conference of Churches, and LV Foster Care families. We will add a handmade card to the bags.

We plan to prepare 450 bags so each organization receives 75 bags! All items need to be <u>new and individually sealed</u> for sanitary reasons. See Holy Happenings weekly for most immediate need.
