Are you taking Required Minimum Distributions? If so, are you aware that your RMD (or a portion of it) can be sent directly to LCHS as a qualified charitable distribution (QCD)? By paying LCHS directly, you can reduce your adjusted gross income when you file your federal taxes. QCDs can be initiated at any time of the year and as early as reaching age 70.5.
