

<u>Financial Results and Discussion - September 2025</u>

Operating Performance: September income was \$63,150, \$3,582 or 5.40% below budget. Operating expenses were \$74,811, \$1,261 or 1.7% below budget. We finished September with a \$11,661 deficit, compared to a budgeted deficit of \$9,340. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirement April - December.

Thank you to everyone that continues to share their financial gifts in support of our ministries!

- **Straight Line at \$120,000**: Represents our 6-week cash requirement to operate the church.
- **Upper Straight Line**: Represents our **current** operating cash balance at the end of each month.
- **Upper Dotted Line:** Represents our **projected** operating cash balance through year end.



Building Fund: The building fund increased \$535.00 during the month and has a balance of \$8,617.44.

Mortgage Update: The mortgage balance as of September 30, 2025, is \$348,565.48.

**Note: The mortgage rate is set to adjust in April 2026 and is expected to be higher. Any funds contributed to Spirit Led, Spirit Alive will be used to pay down the principal balance before the interest rate adjusts on the mortgage.
