

#### Financial Results and Discussion - November 2025

**Operating Performance:** November income was \$105,989, \$35,706 or 50.8% above budget. The church received \$35,000 in pledged and unpledged donations normally received in December, which inflated November's surplus. Operating expenses were \$70,900, \$2,201 or 3.0% below budget. We finished November with a \$35,089 surplus, compared to a budgeted deficit of \$2,818. The graph below presents our operating cash balance shown against our monthly cash requirement **April - December.** 

Thank you to everyone that continues to share their financial gifts in support of our ministries!

- **Straight Line at \$120,000**: Represents our 6-week cash requirement to operate the church.
- **Upper Straight Line**: Represents our **current** operating cash balance at the end of each month.
- **Upper Dotted Line**: Represents our **projected** operating cash balance through year end.



**Building Fund:** The building fund decreased \$352.50 during the month and has a balance of \$4,869.94.

**Mortgage Update:** The mortgage balance as of November 30, 2025, is \$346,443.36.

\*\*Note: The mortgage rate is set to adjust in April 2026 and is expected to be higher. Any funds contributed to Spirit Led, Spirit Alive will be used to pay down the principal balance before the interest rate adjusts on the mortgage.
